### Dog Bins

The dog bins in East Hagbourne are well used and we know that many of you are frustrated that they are often full and overflowing. Parish Council representatives met with SODC to discuss this and as a result the frequency of emptying has been increased at critical locations. Also, the way waste is being handled is changing and bagged dog waste can now be put in general waste bins as well as in the dedicated bins which should give more flexibility.



### Pavements

At the Annual Parish Meeting concerns were raised about the condition of pavements in the parish with areas of Millbrook and the central village. The Parish Council is reviewing the options and will work with SODC and OCC to try and improve the situation.
