### THE FUTURE OF MILLBROOK DEPENDS ON YOU!

Under the Community Governance Review there is a proposal before the District Council to move Millbrook from East Hagbourne Parish to Didcot Parish.

We know from the survey carried out last summer that an overwhelming majority of Millbrook residents want to remain part of East Hagbourne. However the proposal remains on the table and SODC are carrying out a consultation of affected residents before making a final decision in July.

If you live in Millbrook you should have received a letter from SODC dated 4th March 2014 inviting you to comment on the proposal.
