The Pavilion is Nearing Completion

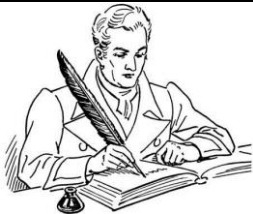

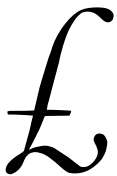


Vacancy - Parish Clerk
