At its meeting on 17th July, South Oxfordshire District Council decided that the area of Millbrook currently part of East Hagbourne parish will become part of Didcot from May next year.

We know from the survey carried out last year that this is against the wishes of most Millbrook residents and we in the Parish Council are disappointed that those views did not carry more weight in the decision - we did argue the case on your behalf at every opportunity during the process.
