New Housing Developments



The planning application for 78 houses behind Blewbury Road is now being considered by SODC and we continue to press OCC to do a thorough evaluation of the access and traffic implications.

We are still waiting to hear when the application to build behind St Hugh's Rise will go to Planning Committee. Catesby's application to build on Park Road will go to appeal in May and we expect a planning application from Taylor Wimpey shortly.

A new initiative called the Oxfordshire Growth Deal has been floated and could bring some protection for planned development, complementing our NP efforts.

Discussions continue on Grainger's fence.
