### Neighbourhood Plan

After a lot of hard work over the summer, our Neighbourhood Plan has now been formally submitted. SODC will now organise a formal consultation which we expect to begin around 1st October and will last six weeks after which the plan and all comments received will be passed to the Examiner.

### New Housing Developments

SODC announced on 14th September that they had refused planning permission for the Persimmon land behind St Hugh's Rise. We expect a decision on the Taylor Wimpey application to the west of Park Road shortly.

The Parish Council has held a preliminary meeting with the builders for the site adjacent to Hagbourne Village Hall. The builders will be in the Village Hall on the 9th October from 3:30 – 8:30pm to receive comments from villagers and to present their current plans.



### Parish Council Surgeries

There will be two surgeries in October both in the Meeting Room of the Village Hall. One will be on the 11th October from 3:30 – 5:30pm and the other on the 16th October from 6:30 – 8:30pm.



### Bus Services - Public Meeting 8th October

The Downland Villages Transport Group (DVTG) was set up to provide a voice for local villages in discussion with bus operators, in particular the 94/94A/94C service. DVTG will be holding their Annual Public Meeting in East Hagbourne this year - 7:30pm on Monday 8th October in East Hagbourne Pavilion.
