Memorials Policy

The Parish Council will consider enquiries concerning Commemorative Memorials that might be sited in the village. The only sites that may be considered are the Recreation Ground and the New Cemetery.

Memorials must be constructed of inert materials and must be capable of being fixed to the ground. Their siting should enhance the location but not inhibit in any way the operation and upkeep of the site. Any future maintenance to a Memorial must be undertaken by the Benefactors. Trees and other plantings will not be considered.

The Council must have sight of the brochures & plans for the Memorial prior to consent being considered.

Once the Memorial and its siting have been approved by the Council the Benefactors will be authorised to install the Memorial at their own costs. No costs shall fall due by the Council.
