As reported at the public meeting on 15th October, we have hit a small hiatus in our Neighbourhood Plan. SODC have raised some questions about our consultation earlier in the year and asked that we include a slightly wider range of national bodies. So, we have invited these organisations to comment and need to wait for their replies before proceeding to the second formal consultation, which we now expect to start in mid-November. The expected date for the referendum remains mid March 2019.

"Leave room for a double pushchair or wheelchair to pass easily"



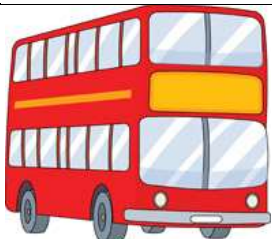
Planning

It is still expected that the full planning application will not be submitted until near the end of the year.

Changes to Bus Services

Thames Travel have announced that they will withdraw the first two morning and last two evening journeys of the 94 bus from 22nd October, because they are not well used. There is an article on the Didcot Herald web site giving more detail.

The Downland Villages Transport Group is working to try and retain at least the first morning bus to Didcot (leaving EH at 07:03), because this is an important service for those who commute in to work or education.



Defibrillator Training
