Neighbourhood Plan Referendum Result

Thank you to everyone who turned out on 14th March and voted in the NP Referendum. The turn-out was 41.3%, significantly higher than the national average, which is a great credit to our community. The votes cast were 93.5% for the Neighbourhood Plan, with 6.5% against.

This means that the Plan already has full legal effect, however a special meeting of SODC will be held on 11th April where it is expected that the plan will be 'made' so that it can continue as part of the SODC development plan.
