Following the local elections on 2nd May, a new set of Councillors has been elected to South Oxfordshire District Council. As you may have seen in the press, there are suggestions that the new Council may consider withdrawing the Local Plan for reconsideration. We believe this would be a mistake, because it could take a considerable time for it to be revised and resubmitted. Without an effective Local Plan, our Neighbourhood Plan could be weakened in the future. The NP Steering Group, in conjunction with the Parish Council is contacting other NP groups to start a discussion on this and we also plan to speak at the SODC Cabinet meeting when this matter is considered.



Openreach Faster Broadband Delivery
