- Facilitate and support the successful provision of primary and pre-school education within the village and provide as necessary for possible future expansion

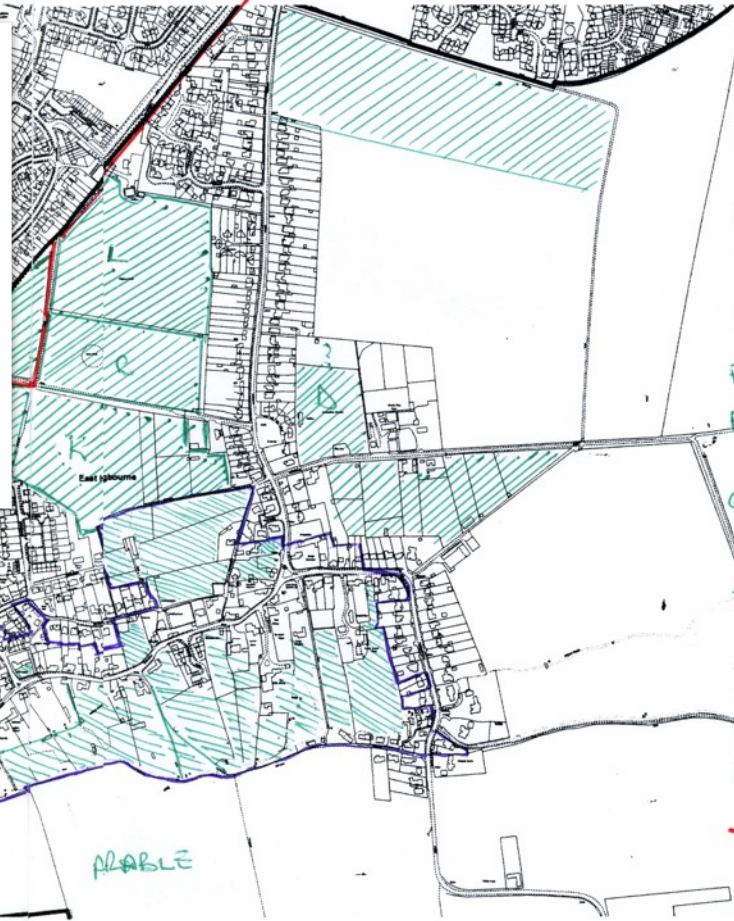


What have we done so far?

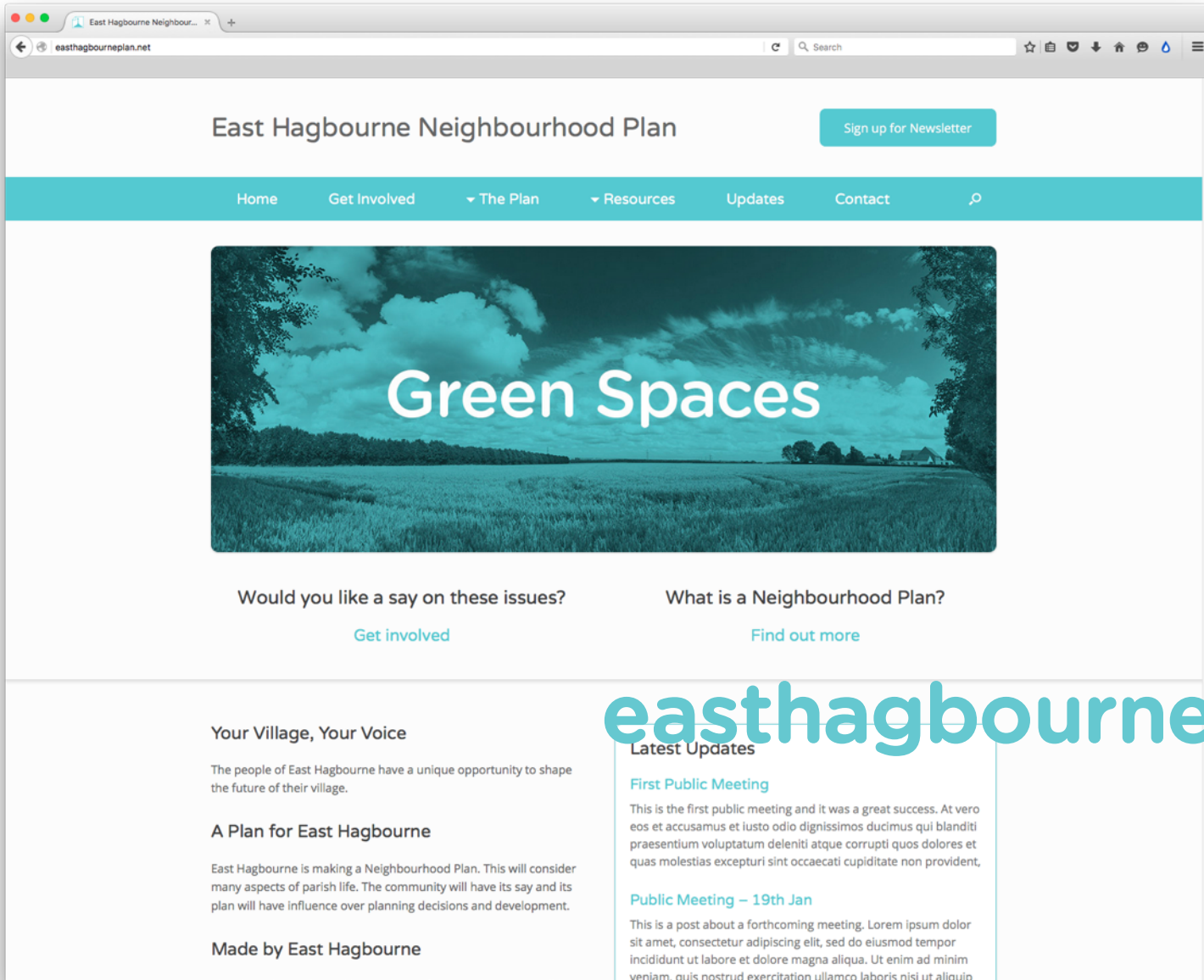
