Following a detailed assessment of the village benches, the Parish Council has prioritized 6 benches to be refurbished and repainted this year. The work will be carried out by a local handyman. The remaining benches will be refurbished later as part of an ongoing plan.

**Parish Council Car Park**

The council have been considering the usage of the village hall car park prior to the commencement of the new housing development and are currently finalising some guidelines.

Installation of a simple sign at the entrance to the car park and signage to discourage unauthorised usage of the disabled parking spaces are planned. The car park lighting was upgraded earlier this year and will have a significant impact on electricity usage in the future.

The council has also arranged for the car park drains to be cleared in a bid to reduce any surface water during periods of heavy rainfall.
