**Oxfordshire County Council – Waste Centre Closures**

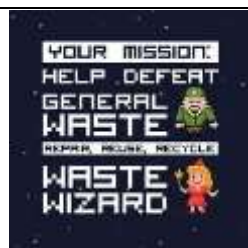
During March and April, your Household Waste Recycling Centres will be closing for two days to carry out a deep clean and essential maintenance.
