**New Dog Waste Bin Location**

The Parish Council are planning to install a larger dog waste bin at the top of the Harwood Road footpath to Millennium Wood, as the existing bin is too small for the location. We are also planning a new location for a small dog waste bin location on the Wilcher Close green area next to the entrance to North Croft. It will be mounted on its own post, and positioned away from the Poets' Trail plaque nearer to the hedge. An approximate location is shown in the photo.
