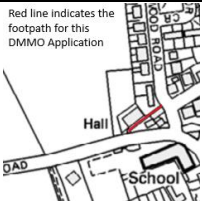
REPORTING ISSUES IN THE PARISH

There has been an increase in recent months of reported issues such as fallen trees, damage to verges, potholes, footpath concerns and street lighting. The majority of these issues are the responsibility of Oxfordshire County Council or South Oxfordshire District Council and the best way to report them is using one of the websites listed below. This is important to ensure the issues are logged with the correct department and actioned. <https://www.fixmystreet.com/> allows you to report on a wide variety of issues and the reports are forwarded to Oxfordshire County Council or South Oxfordshire District Council depending on the nature of the problem. You can request updates to be sent and follow up with further comments on your post if you wish. <https://publicrightsofway.oxfordshire.gov.uk/standardmap.aspx> can be used if the issue is with a countryside path or public right of way. Reports are again forwarded to the relevant departments and dealt with accordingly.
