BENCHES IN THE PARISH



The walkers among you may well have noticed that the restoration of the art benches along the old railway embankment is well under way. This project has involved the parishes of East Hagbourne, West Hagbourne and Upton, as well as Sustrans who are the custodians of the national cycling network. VILLAGE PARKING

Some of the older properties do not have off-street parking and park responsibly on the road as a necessity, however this does mean there are sections particularly along Main Road where it is essential to drive carefully due to the narrow width of the road to avoid oncoming traffic, as well as cyclists and pedestrians.
