

## **Hagbourne Village Hall reopening**

Now that the government is moving towards opening up society generally, but is advising us to all remain cautious, the following will apply from 19<sup>th</sup> July in the Village Hall: -

Since good ventilation is one way to combat the spread of the virus, the ventilation `system should be used at all times, with a setting of not less than 2. In addition, windows should be opened where possible.

Please continue with the wearing of face masks, as well as the regular washing of hands and/or the use hand sanitiser regularly throughout your stay in the hall. We will ensure the hand wash facilities as well as the hand sanitizer remain available for use.

Continue to use the QR code scan or the register so that we may identify all those who may have come into contact with someone who is later identified as being infected, and the appropriate steps can then be taken.

Please cover your nose and mouth when you cough and sneeze.

Consider individual risks, such as clinical vulnerabilities and vaccination status.

From 19<sup>th</sup> July, all limits on numbers in the hall are likely to be removed, and concerts, singing and dancing can resume without any limits on attendance or social distancing requirements.

However, it should be recognised that the pandemic is not over and with the number of cases being reported in Oxford being at a high level, restrictions may have to be reintroduced.

In the meantime, please begin to enjoy using the hall once again, whilst reporting anyone who is tested positive for Corona Virus within your attendance group.
