

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(EAST HAGBOURNE) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\***

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order, following road safety concerns raised by the Parish Council, is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** replacing the existing 30mph speed limit on various roads within East Hagbourne as follows.

1. Main Road – from a point 50 metres south west of its junction with the Didcot – Blewbury road (B4016) (west of the War Memorial triangle) westwards to a point 50 metres west of its junction with Manor Farm Lane,
2. Harwood Road – in its entirety,
3. The Croft – from its junction with Wilcher Close, westwards to its junction with Harwood Road
4. Lake Road – in its entirety,
5. Church Close – in its entirety,
6. Kingsholme Close – in its entirety.

The Oxfordshire County Council (East Hagbourne) (Speed Limits) Order 1999 will be revoked/replaced.
