**VILLAGE HALL FOOTPATH UPDATE**



The Definitive Map Modification Order for the footpath from Harwood Road alongside the village hall to the zebra crossing on Main Road opposite the school was uncontended. The order was confirmed by Oxfordshire County Council on 28<sup>th</sup> March, making this path an official public right of way known as Footpath 30. The Notice of Confirmation and plan are on display on the village noticeboard until 20<sup>th</sup> May.



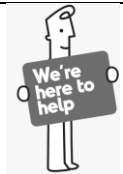
**PAVILION CAR PARK**
