HEDGE CUTTING AT THE CEMETERY

The hedge along the front of the Cemetery has been recently cut back. The Cemetery Committee recognizes that this was intended to be a helpful endeavour, but it is currently bird nesting season and hedge cutting is not advised during this time to protect nesting sites in line with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. Hedge cutting is arranged outside of the nesting season and the Committee kindly asks individuals not to undertake works of this nature at the Cemetery without approval.
