

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(EAST AND WEST HAGBOURNE) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\***

Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (East and West Hagbourne) (Speed Limits) Order 202\* and shall come into force on the     day of             202\*.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. The roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (East Hagbourne) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 is hereby revoked.

**SCHEDULE 1**

20mph Speed Limit:

**East Hagbourne**

a)	Church Close	In its entirety
b)	Harwood Road	In its entirety

e)	Kingsholme Close	In its entirety
d)	Lake Road	In its entirety
e)	Main Road	From a point 50 metres southwest of its junction with the B4016 Didcot — Blewbury road, westwards to a point 50 metres west of its junction with Manor Farm Lane.
f)	The Crofts	From its junction with Wilcher Close, westwards to its junction with Harwood Road

## PART A

The whole length of every road in the village of East Hagbourne extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	B4016 Blewbury Road	a point 110 metres south of its junction with Fieldside
b)	B4016 New Road	a point 40 metres north of its junction with Rymans Crescent
c)	Main Road	a point 50 metres west of its junction with Manor Farm Lane.

## PART B

d)	Bishops Orchard	from its junction with New Road, westwards	for its entire length

## West Hagbourne

The whole length of every road in the village of West Hagbourne extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Brook Lane	a point 15 metres north of its junction with Main Street.
b)	Foxglove Lane	a point 128 metres east of its junction with Main Street.
c)	Main Street	a point 300 meters west of the western boundary of the Horse and Harrow public house.
d)	The unnamed road to the A417	a point 65 metres south of its junction with Main Street.

## SCHEDULE 2

30mph Speed Limit:

### East Hagbourne

a)	Bishops Orchard	from its junction with New Road for its entire length.	
b)	B4016 Blewbury Road	from its junction with Main Road to a point 112 metres south of Fieldside.	
e)	Higgs Close	from its junction with New Road for its entire length.	
h)	Main Road	from its junction with the B4016 Didcot – Blewbury road, south-westwards for 50 metres.	
i)	B4016 New Road	from its junction with Jubilee Way, southwards	to its junction with Main Road a point 40 metres north of its junction with Rymans Crescent

## SCHEDULE 3

50mph speed limit:

### West Hagbourne

a)	Main Street	from a point 300 meters west of the western boundary of the Horse and Harrow public house, westwards	to its junction with the A417 London Road
